It represented the culmination of years of planning and the transition to the construction phase of the project.

PARC will allow for dynamic utilization day and night, making after school, work and weekend use more accessible to a substantial number of current and potential Scouting members. Partnerships with local commercial, civic, and conservation organizations are being developed to ensure interactive and engaging experiences for every PARC visitor.

Nick Giuffre, volunteer Vice President of Development for Chester County Boy Scouts, highlighted the milestone in history for our Boy Scout Council. "It is the first new program campus to be developed by and for Chester County Council since the 1920s," Nick said. "PARC will serve as a vital hub for Scouts, volunteers, and community members...."

Construction on the Daniel Tabas Family Program Center is expected to finish in late 2019. HL Wiker, Inc. has begun to grade the campus to prepare for the new building construction.
